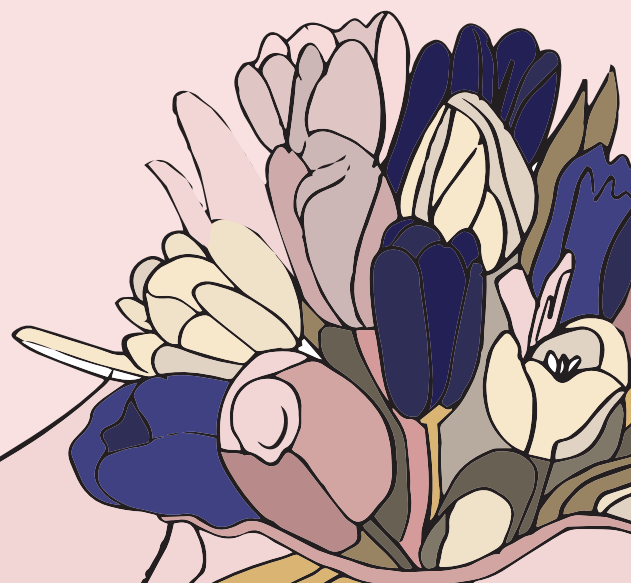


2019/2020 reflect + plan
